New Haven Home Recovery (NHHR) proudly announces the opening of its Thrift Store at 30 Morris Avenue in West Haven. All proceeds from the Thrift Store benefit the women and children living in the NHHR homeless shelters, families living in the NHHR supportive housing programs and The Furniture Co-op.

NHHR has been providing supportive services and housing to families since 1990. The agency's mission is to promote the independence of women and children confronting homelessness, HIV/AIDS, and behavioral health issues in a supportive environment where their potential can be realized. NHHR operates two emergency homeless shelters for women and children, over 100 units of supportive housing for families and two family stabilization programs, one in Fair Haven and one in Bridgeport. In addition, NHHR operates a regional furniture bank called The Furniture Co- Op and a thrift store, which provides donated furniture to households in need: www.nhhr.org.

The Thrift Store is managed by volunteer Karen Greenberg and staffed entirely by volunteers. It's currently open Saturday's from 9am to 1pm and Tuesdays from 9am to 2pm. The Thrift Store inventory includes a variety of furniture items, TVs, lamps, artwork, jewelry, books, tapes, linens, clothing, shoes, dishes, glasses, collectables and much more.

Donations are accepted during normal business hours at the Thrift Store. You can also drop off donations at Tzedakah House, 8 Lunar Drive in Woodbridge Monday through Friday from 8:30am to 5:00pm. A pick up service is available for larger items (203-492-4866 ext. *813).
